



ELECTRIC WHEELCHAIRS' REGULATION

1 – Object and Structure

This Regulation contains the General Conditions for the supply and use of the free service of electric wheelchairs for people with motor disabilities, owned by the Archaeological and Landscape Park of the Valley of the Temples.

The Park offers a service free of charge to its visitors with special needs, who must, however, always follow the fundamental principles ruled by the Highway Code's traffic regulation. The fulfillment of the mentioned Code starts from the booking, continues during the use and ends with the return of the vehicle at the place of delivery.

The management of the devices - including their maintenance, correct functioning, delivery and return - is guaranteed by the Body: the delivery and return operations of the devices are carried out by the Body's custody staff, which is placed at the guardhouse that precedes the ticket office of the Temple of Juno.

The concessionaire of the additional services receives the timetable of the bookings of the devices and forward them to the staff of the Body.

2 – Duration and termination of the contract

2.1. The booking of the service is considered completed from the date of communication of the registration by e-mail from CoopCulture. Any of the parties may proceed with its resolution at any time.

2.2. The user can request the cancellation of the service by calling CoopCulture call center +39 (0)922/1839996 (Monday-Saturday from 10.00 to 15.00) or by sending an email to biglietteria.giunone@coopculture.it

2.3. The equipment is subject to shifts: it is possible to use a device every hour and a half with its return within three hours. The return of the device must take place in the same area where the user has previously take nit over.

3 – User obligations

3.1. The User has the right, once the reservation is completed, to be able to use the vehicles.

3.2. The User must make use of the service and, specifically, of the vehicle in compliance with the Highway Code and, in general, with the diligence of a "good family man", without causing any damage to the vehicle.

3.3. The User will be provided with a map of the areas and routes within the Valley of the Temples which can be visited with wheelchair.

3.4. The Archaeological and Landscape Park of the Valley of the Temples is excluded from any liability for damages to things or people caused by an improper or clumsy use of the vehicle.
